INSURANCE DECLARATION:			
I declare that the above vessel is insured for third party risks, in a sum of not less than £2,000,000, to cover my use of her on the Mersey.			
I further declare that I will not allow guests to use the vessel unless their use of her is also covered by this or similar insurance and that I will maintain the insurance in force for as long as I use or store this vessel at Liverpool Sailing Club.

Boat Park Bylaws

If at any time any berthing fees or subscriptions payable to the club by any member or former member shall be three months or more in arrears:

(a) The committee shall be entitled to move the boat to any other part of the premises without being liable for any loss or damage to the boat howsoever caused.

(b) The committee shall be entitled upon giving one month's notice in writing to the member or former member, at his last known address shown in the register of members, to sell the boat and to deduct any monies due to the club (whether by way of arrears of subscription or mooring or berthing fees or otherwise) from the net proceeds of sale before accounting for the balance (if any) to the member or former member.

(c) Alternatively any boat which in the opinion of the committee cannot be sold may, upon such notice as aforesaid, be disposed of in any manner the committee may think fit and the expenses recovered from the member or former member. Any arrears as aforesaid shall be deemed to be a debt owing to the club by the member or former member.

(d) Further the club shall, at all times, have a lien over members' or former members' boats parked or moored on the club's premises or club moorings in respect of all monies due to the club, whether in respect of arrears of mooring fees or subscriptions or otherwise.

(e) All boats while stored on the boat park or in the club grounds shall be covered by 3rd party insurance for a minimum of £2,000,000.

Note.

Each berth in the Boat Park is normally conditional upon the boat being used regularly.

Annual renewal of a berth may be declined if the boat has not been in regular use the previous year.

For new applications for a berth there is no requirement for use in the previous year, but we will expect an indication of the intention to use the boat regularly.

The Committee will consider extenuating circumstances if for good reason a boat cannot meet the usage requirement.

Berths for boats not meeting the above usage conditions will be at the sole discretion of the General Committee.
